Do Your Part! - East Franklin Township Announces Vehicle Recycle program

For immediate release – March 30, 2018 – Kittanning, PA -- East Franklin Township, in conjunction with the P.J. Greco & Sons, 593 Tarrtown Road and the state's "Pick It Up PA Days", is announcing a vehicle salvage program to properly remove and recycle unregistered and inoperable motor vehicles.

The Township Supervisors and Zoning Officer Greg McKelvey believe this program can be an effective and efficient way for residents to remove vehicles that should be salvaged but just haven't found a method to accomplish.

"Each spring and fall we have designated "Trash Days" at the Township building for our residents, but large items such as vehicles, cannot be included in a dumpster collection," McKelvey said. "With this program that we have instituted with Greco's we have made things as simple as possible. A Greco's representative will come right to your site, load the vehicle or vehicles on a tilt bed truck and take it to their facility. Not only do you get rid of an unwanted vehicle, you will get paid for the transaction."

Keys to the Program:

- Contact Lenae Lasher at 724.868.2534 to schedule the tilt bed truck for pickup and delivery of the vehicle(s). The vehicle should have all or most of its tires.
- **You must possess the correct Title for the vehicle. Whoever's name is on the front of the Title must come to Greco's to sign over the title. If there are two names on the Title, they both must be present to legally make this transfer. Also, you will need to show your driver's license.**
- Currently **Whole** vehicles are paying \$9.50 per 100 lb. (prices subject to change at any time). For example, if an automobile weighs 3,500 lbs. it will pay \$332. * If it weighs 4,000 lbs. it will pay \$380.
- Upon completion of a proper transaction individuals can receive the corresponding cash, in person, at the P.J. Greco & Sons business location. Tracy Blair, of Greco's, will handle the payment. The P.J. Greco phone number is 724.543.1052.

Township ordinances call for no motor vehicle to be parked on a residential lot, without a current registration for more than 30 days, unless the vehicle is completely fenced in or located in a building or garage.

"We are direct mailing several residents about this program and are seeking cooperation to avoid further enforcement," McKelvey said. "We encourage the public to utilize and inform residents of vehicles that may apply to this program. If I can assist with arrangements in any way please contact me."

"Pick It Up PA Days" runs April 7-30 and is part of the Great American Cleanup program which runs all spring.
