An underdrain was installed on Nolte. Dr. A driveway pipe was installed at 149 Walkchalk Rd. 180 feet of culvert pipe was installed at 373 Walkchalk Rd. to correct a drainage problem. 4 New catch basins and 280 ft of pipe were installed on Johns Rd. We

continue our roadside mowing. Some minor repairs were made on the equipment.
