**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

**Residents from T. Claypoole Road – Donna Scholl, Devon Wolfe and Martin Gray:**

**Donna Scholl** – We live on Tiny Claypoole Road and are here to see how we can start the process of getting public water for the residents on our road. Would there be any money/grants that we could receive to help with the cost?

**Barry Peters, Chairman** – The Water Authority received an estimated price of \$400,000.00 to run that service line. If the residents were low income, we could use CDBG funds. I am on the Water Authority Board and we very seldom get grants. We apply for Pennvest loans.

**Devon Wolfe** - I talked to a person from PA Small Water and she said there are grants for water with no income limits for any water projects.

**Barry Peters, Chairman** – The Township currently has \$50,000.00 designated for water from Act 13 funds. The Township is receiving Covid-19 funds but have not received the guidelines on how it can be used.

**David Stewart** - I would inquire with the water authority, county and state for funding. The water line starts in Washington Township so they will need to be aware and contribute something to the project.

**Donna Scholl** – So we can tell them the Township has money to put towards the project (\$50,000.00)?

**David Stewart** – Yes, we have \$50,000.00 setback for water projects.

**Dean Hepler, Resident** – We talked last month about the township trucks being driven to Sarver. How many times a month is the truck being used?

**David Stewart**, Supervisor – The road crew is working on getting the roads ready for the township paving, seal coat and base repair on Boltz road.
