The Sewage Department's Emergency Response Plan was reviewed and updated.

The flow meters at all four Sewage Treatment Plants were calibrated. We will receive a certification for each plant. DEP requires that all flow meters be calibrated on a yearly basis.

One real estate transfer inspection was done in Tarrtown.

There was a one-call for all of Tarrtown.

Shut-Off Water Notices were posted on the applicable houses.

All required lab samples for October were collected and transported to CWM. DMR reports for the month of September 2021 were submitted to DEP.
