Road Report for January 2021

We have been out salting, and ashing the roads. Working on our dirt roads, cleaning the ditches, filling holes, and spreading stone over muddy spots. Potholes were filled with coldpatch. We had a couple calls for trees down on the roads. A catch basin was installed on Lemon Hollow Rd and a catch basin was installed along Pence Rd. The boom mower was serviced. #1 limestone was placed in a deep ditch along Elm Dr. The salt building was restocked:

Approximately 200 tons of salt Approximately 90 tons of anti-skid Some minor repairs were made on the equipment.

February has been a busy month! We have been out plowing snow, salting, and ashing the roads nearly every day. We also had some rainfall, freezing rain, and some very windy days. We had a few calls from 911 for slippery roads. The salt building was restocked:

Approximately 230 tons of salt Approximately 90 tons of anti-skid Approximately 50 tons of Ashes Some minor repairs were made on the equipment.

March was mostly spent cleaning up the roads from winter. All the roads were swept to remove the anti-skid. Many potholes were filled with coldpatch. Limestone was spread on the dirt roads. Some ditches were cleaned. We got three of the trucks inspected this month. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment.

The salt spreaders were removed from the trucks, washed, oiled, and put away for the summer.

The restrooms and pavilion at Heritage Park were cleaned and the water was turned back on. Many potholes were filled and ditches cleaned out. The oil was changed in the township pickup truck. A culvert pipe was installed on Coal St. and also Furnace Run Rd to correct a water drainage problem. We also did some patching on Deer Run Rd. and Furnace Run Rd. to repair some bad spots. Some minor repairs were done on the equipment.

Road Report for May 2021

May started with Spring Clean-up. We took in 8 dumpsters full of garbage, 2 dumpsters full of scrap metal, and 7 pallets of tvs that were hauled to a recycle center in Greensburg.

The restrooms at Heritage Park were cleaned and opened for the season.

Mowing our right-of-ways has begun.

A driveway pipe was installed along Lemmon Hollow Rd.

Many potholes were filled with cold patch.

The dirt roads were graded and stone was spread where needed. We had 2 911 calls for trees that had fallen on roads. Some minor repairs were made on the equipment.

Wiest Asphalt Paving completed our paving project for the year. Commerce Dr. and Sherwood Dr. were paved. A 60" culvert pipe was replaced on Furnace Run Rd. Catch basins and pipe were installed along Boltz Rd. We have been getting roads ready for our sealcoat project which is scheduled for mid-July. Stone was spread on the dirt roads, and they were graded. We continue our roadside mowing. Some minor repairs were made on the equipment.

Road Report for July 2021

July was primarily spent preparing for our sealcoat project which was completed on Wednesday. Ditches were cleaned, roads were graded and rolled, coldpatch was placed in many small holes. A 24" pipe was installed on Walkchalk Rd. A 48" pipe was installed on Lemon Hollow Rd. Two driveway pipes were installed on Preston Ln, and one on Woodland Dr. A list of the roads that were seal coated will follow. The intersection at Franklin Village was repainted at Penn Dot's request. We had several calls for trees on the roads. We continue our roadside mowing. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment.

Several bad spots on Deer Run Rd. were dug out and patched. Culvert pipe and 2 catch basins were installed along Campbell Dr. East American Inc. completed our project on Boltz Rd. The road was ground up and limestone added, graded, rolled, and a surface treatment was applied. The large pine trees at the end of Wible Rd were trimmed of all the low hanging branches. Several new STOP signs were put up in the Sedwick Plan to replace old faded ones. 15" pipe and 2 catch basins were installed along Montgomery Rd. to correct a water drainage problem. We had multiple calls from Armstrong 911 for trees that had fallen on the road. We continue our roadside mowing.

Road Report for September 2021

Russell Standard completed our sealcoat project on Montgomery Rd. The ditches on Boltz Rd., Walnut Bottom Rd., and Pence Rd. were cleaned. Stone was spread on the dirt roads and they were graded and rolled. Approximately 90 tons of ashes were delivered and stockpiled for the upcoming winter season. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment. Two of the trucks were inspected. Some landscaping was done at the new park in Tarrtown. We had one call from 911 for a tree on the road. We continue the mowing of our right-of-ways.

Road Report for October 2021

This month was fall clean-up. We took in 4 dumpsters full of garbage, 1 dumpster full of scrap metal, and 2 pallets full of televisions. The TVs were hauled to a recycle center in Greensburg. Heritage Park was closed for the season. The restrooms were winterized and closed. The right of way for the sewage line in Fox Hollow Estates was mowed off. The sewage pickup truck was serviced. Several dirt roads were graded and the ditches cleaned. Potholes were patched. The trees along Commerce Dr. were trimmed. We had 1 callout from 911 for a stop sign down on Wible Rd. We continue our roadside mowing.

Materials were ordered and delivered for the upcoming winter season.

Approximately 115 tons of salt, 50 tons of anti-skid, and 200 tons of ashes were delivered and stockpiled. All of our storm drains were cleaned. The salt spreaders were installed on two of the trucks. New rear tires were installed on our 2004 GMC, and new tires were installed on our 2016 Ford F550. The lawn mowers were cleaned up and serviced. Potholes were filled on the dirt roads. The ditches were cleaned on the dirt roads and the roads were graded. A catch basin was installed along Boltz Rd. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment.

Road Report for December 2021

We got our first taste of winter on Thanksgiving Day. We were out salting roads that evening, and several times that weekend. The ditches were cleaned on the dirt roads and limestone was placed in the holes. Stone was placed in the ditches along Rolling Hills Road where they were washed out. Our 2015 Ford F550 was in the shop for a new turbo. A large tow behind leaf blower was borrowed from the county. We used this to blow the leaves out of the ditches on many the roads. The weekend of the 11th was very windy. We had multiple callouts for trees on the roads. Several dead trees were cut and removed along Walkchalk Rd. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment.
