

## Road Report for January 2023

---

Several trees were cleaned up that came down during the wintery weather around Christmas. A 36 inch culvert pipe was installed on Campbell Dr. This work was done with the West Hills Area Water Pollution Control Authority. The sanitary sewer main was being exposed by the discharge of water from our culvert. We worked together to correct the problem. Stone was placed in holes on the dirt roads, and cold patch was used on the paved roads. Ditches were cleaned out. Several dead trees were cut down along the roads. We were out plowing and treating the roads a few times. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment.

## Road Report for February 2023

---

Although we have had a very mild winter so far, we were out a handful of times treating the roads with salt and ash. Stone was placed in holes on the dirt roads, and cold patch was used on the paved roads. Ditches were cleaned out. Several dead trees were cut down along the roads. We were called to assist the fire company multiple times when a house burned on Carpenter Dr. Stone was placed along Wible Rd. to fill in the low shoulder. We had one callout from 911 for a tree on the road. Underdrain and a crosspipe were installed on Lemon Hollow Rd. A couple really soft spots on Quigley Hill Rd were dug out and filled with stone. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment.

## Road Report for March 2023

---

We were only out one time treating the roads with salt and ash this month. All of the paved roads were swept to remove the anti-skid material from winter. New brushes were installed on both brooms. Stone was placed in holes on the dirt roads, and cold patch was used on the paved roads. Ditches and storm drains were cleaned out. The two Ford F550s were inspected. We were called to assist the fire company when Smith's Auto Sales burned. We had multiple callouts from 911 for trees on the roads last weekend during the heavy rain and wind storm. Two 18" crosspipes were installed on Rolling Hills Rd. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment.

## Road Report for April 2023

---

April has had some stormy and windy days. We had several calls for trees on roadways. Many road signs were blown over and needed to be put back up. Storm drains were covered with debris from the heavy rains and needed to be cleaned off. The salt spreaders were removed, washed, oiled, and put away for the season. Stone was placed in holes on the dirt roads, and cold patch was used on the paved roads. The mowing season has begun. Most of the properties we maintain have been mowed at least once. The water was turned on at Heritage Park and the restrooms opened for the summer. Some improvements were made at the new playground in Tarrtown.
