

Road Report for January 2023

Several trees were cleaned up that came down during the wintery weather around Christmas. A 36 inch culvert pipe was installed on Campbell Dr. This work was done with the West Hills Area Water Pollution Control Authority. The sanitary sewer main was being exposed by the discharge of water from our culvert. We worked together to correct the problem. Stone was placed in holes on the dirt roads, and cold patch was used on the paved roads. Ditches were cleaned out. Several dead trees were cut down along the roads. We were out plowing and treating the roads a few times. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment.

Road Report for February 2023

Although we have had a very mild winter so far, we were out a handful of times treating the roads with salt and ash. Stone was placed in holes on the dirt roads, and cold patch was used on the paved roads. Ditches were cleaned out. Several dead trees were cut down along the roads. We were called to assist the fire company multiple times when a house burned on Carpenter Dr. Stone was placed along Wible Rd. to fill in the low shoulder. We had one callout from 911 for a tree on the road. Underdrain and a crosspipe were installed on Lemon Hollow Rd. A couple really soft spots on Quigley Hill Rd were dug out and filled with stone. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment.

Road Report for March 2023

We were only out one time treating the roads with salt and ash this month. All of the paved roads were swept to remove the anti-skid material from winter. New brushes were installed on both brooms. Stone was placed in holes on the dirt roads, and cold patch was used on the paved roads. Ditches and storm drains were cleaned out. The two Ford F550s were inspected. We were called to assist the fire company when Smith's Auto Sales burned. We had multiple callouts from 911 for trees on the roads last weekend during the heavy rain and wind storm. Two 18" crosspipes were installed on Rolling Hills Rd. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment.

Road Report for April 2023

April has had some stormy and windy days. We had several calls for trees on roadways. Many road signs were blown over and needed to be put back up. Storm drains were covered with debris from the heavy rains and needed to be cleaned off. The salt spreaders were removed, washed, oiled, and put away for the season. Stone was placed in holes on the dirt roads, and cold patch was used on the paved roads. The mowing season has begun. Most of the properties we maintain have been mowed at least once. The water was turned on at Heritage Park and the restrooms opened for the summer. Some improvements were made at the new playground in Tarrtown.

Road Report for May 2023

May started out with our spring clean-up. We took in 6 dumpsters full of garbage, and 2 full of scrap metal during the two days. A catch basin was installed along Oak Dr. to correct a drainage issue. Stone was placed in holes on the dirt roads, and cold patch was used on the paved roads. Calcium Chloride was spread on a section of Rolling Hills Rd. to control the dust. We had 2 calls from 911 for trees on the road. We continue the roadside mowing.

Road Report for June 2023

A catch basin was installed along Pleasantview Dr. to correct a drainage issue. Stone was placed in holes on the dirt roads, and cold patch was used on the paved roads. The ditches were cleaned on the dirt roads. We had 2 calls from 911 for trees on the road. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment. We continue the roadside mowing.

Road Report for July 2023

Russell Standard has completed our paving and sealcoat projects for the summer. Portions of Briar Hill Rd. and Frick Dr. were paved. A list of the sealcoat roads is attached. Cold patch was placed in holes on the paved roads and stone was used on the gravel roads. Ditches were cleaned. We continue our roadside mowing and the mowing of the parks and sewage treatment plants. The frisbee golf course at the park was mowed off. We had only one callout for a tree on the road. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment.

Road Report for August 2023

A 12 inch pipe and catch basin were installed on Frick Dr. A 36 inch pipe was installed on Lemmon Hollow Rd. A 15 inch pipe and catch basin were installed on Manor Lane. All of these were to replace old tin pipes that were rusted out. Cold patch was placed in holes on the paved roads and stone was used on the gravel roads. Ditches were cleaned. We continue our roadside mowing and the mowing of the parks and sewage treatment plants. We had only one callout for a tree on the road. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment.

Road Report for September 2023

Several spots on Ken Wolfe Rd. were dug out and patched. Some of the dirt roads were graded and limestone was spread on them. Cold patch was placed in holes on the paved roads and stone was used on the gravel roads. Ditches and storm drains were cleaned. We continue our roadside mowing and the mowing of the parks and sewage treatment plants. We had only one callout for a tree on the road. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment.

Road Report for October 2023

October started with our Fall Clean-up. We took in 4 dumpsters full of trash and 1 dumpster full of scrap metal. Also 30 televisions were collected. 240feet of 18inch pipe and 3 catch basins were installed along Carpenter Dr. Limestone was placed in the deep ditches along Glacial Sand Rd. 100 feet of 24inch pipe was installed along Sotos Rd. Some of the dirt roads were graded and limestone was spread on them. Cold patch was placed in holes on the paved roads and stone was used on the gravel roads. Ditches and storm drains were cleaned. Heritage Park was closed and winterized for the season. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment.

Road Report for November 2023

The lawn mowers and boom mower were washed, serviced, and put in the maintenance building for the winter. Ashes were delivered and stockpiled. Approximately 40 tons of asphalt millings were spread on the steep hill on T Claypool Rd. Cold patch was placed in holes on the paved roads and stone was used on the gravel roads. Ditches and storm drains were cleaned. The GMC 1 ton was inspected. The salt spreaders were installed on the trucks. We had one callout from 911 for a tree on Lash Rd. We were out salting the roads 1 time. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment.

Road Report for December 2023

December has been a pretty slow month. The ditches were cleaned on almost all the roads to remove the leaves. Cold patch was placed in holes on the paved roads and stone was used on the gravel roads. Storm drains were cleaned. We were out salting and ashing the roads a couple times. The Sewage pickup truck was serviced. A few minor repairs were made on the equipment.
